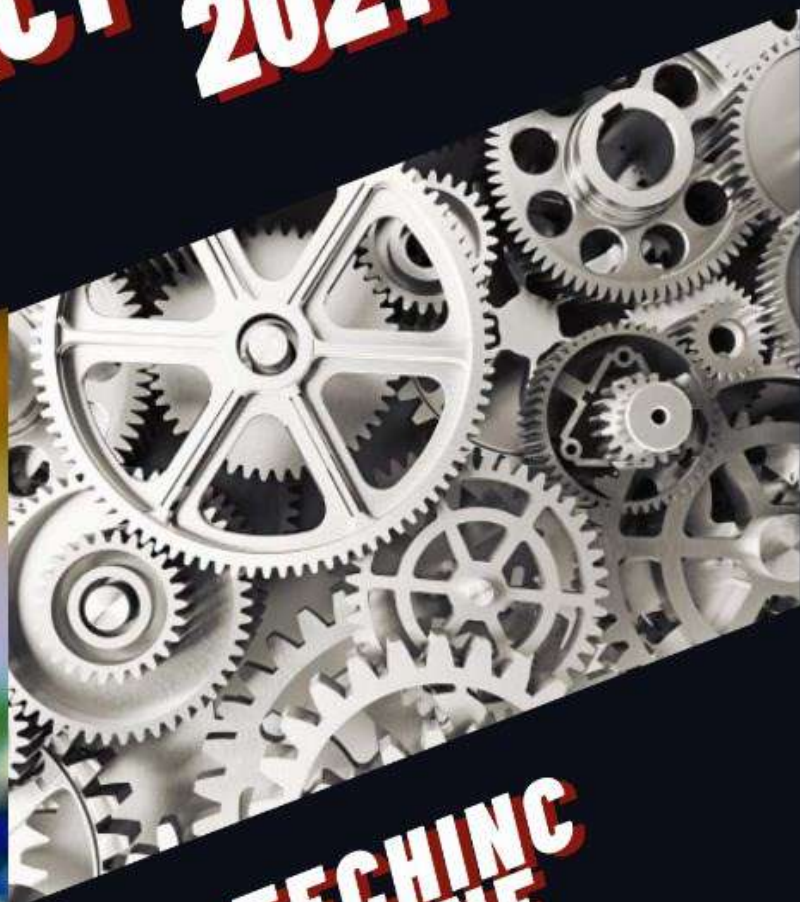
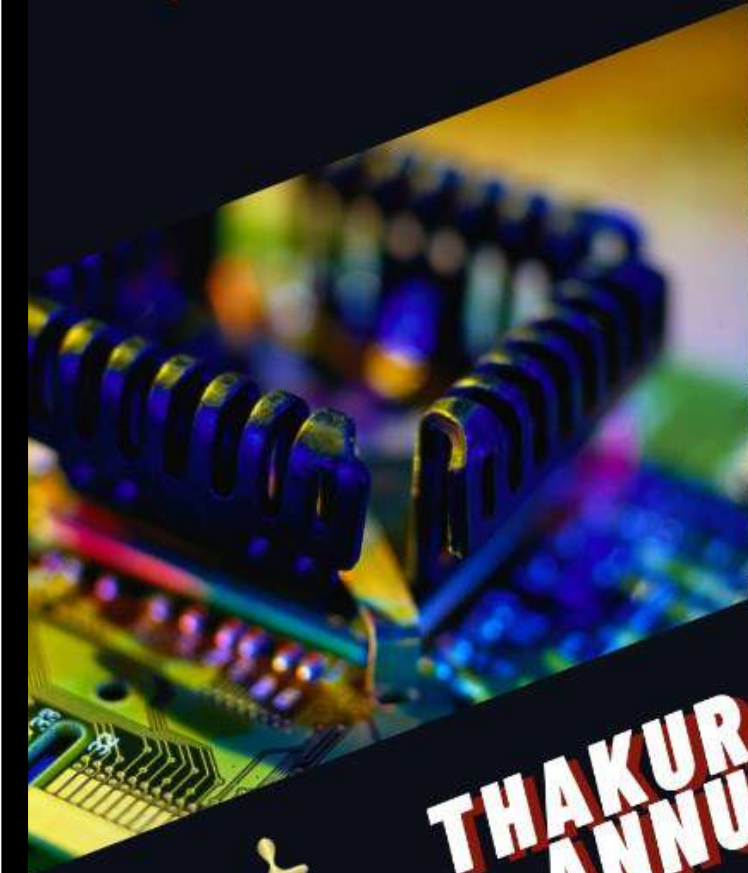

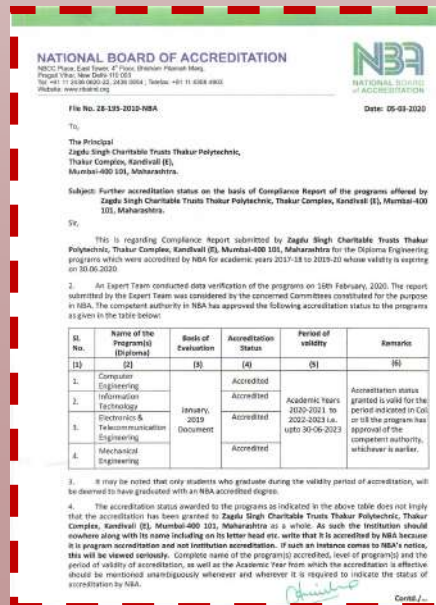

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## About Thakur Polytechnic

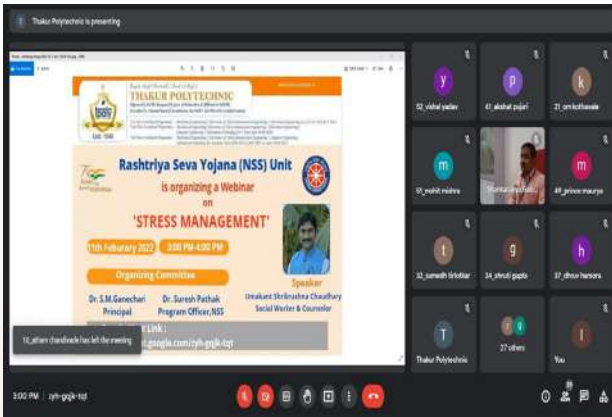


### SEMINAR ON STRESS MANAGEMENT
